Martham Boat Dyke Trust – Terms & Conditions - Revised Nov 2018

General Conditions of the Use of Property and Moorings at Martham Boat Dyke

Summary of Key points

Mooring

All vessels and vehicles in or on the Trust Property may be moved by the Trust to any other part of the same property but will only do so with good cause.

The Trust shall not be liable for any loss, theft or any other damage of whatsoever nature caused to any vessel or vehicle or other property of the Owner. The Owner shall be responsible for maintenance of all staging, pontoons and other mooring aids, not erected or installed by the Trust and ensure that they are in safe condition and reserves the right to require boat owners to carry out satisfactory repairs. No sub letting of the mooring is permitted without the agreement of the Trust. The Owner shall notify the Trust within 7 days of any sale of any vessel which is subject to a current Licence granted to the Owner by the Trust.

Payment

All invoices for moorings are produced for the period 1 April to 31 March with invoices usually sent out on 1 March. Settlement shall be made by 1 April and if settlement is not made within 28 days of the invoice date it will be assumed that the mooring is no longer required and it will be re-allocated.

Insurance

The Owner shall maintain third party insurance in respect of himself and each of his vehicles or vessel, his crew and his agents, visitors, guests and sub-contractors. The Owner shall produce the policy or policies to the Trust on demand. The Owner shall provide and maintain at least one fire extinguisher in or on the vessel fit for immediate use. The Owner shall be responsible for the repair of any damages caused by the Owner to Trust property.

On Site Maintenance

No work shall be done to the vessel by the Owner whilst at the Trust property without the written consent of the Trust, other than minor running repairs or minor maintenance of a routine nature. Owners are to exercise great care and caution when handling fuel or refuelling.

Car Parking

Owners and their crews are required to park their motor vehicles in such a position and in such a manner as shall from time to time be directed by the Trust.

Residence

No residential moorings. You are not allowed to reside on your vessel whilst it is moored at the Trust's property.

Trading

No part of the Trust's property or of any vessel or vehicle while situated therein or thereon shall be used by the Owner for any commercial purposes.

Nuisance

The behaviour of Owners shall not cause any nuisance or annoyance to any other users of Trust property.

Termination

The Trust shall have the right to terminate the Licence granted to the Owner. The Trust or Owner may terminate the Licence by giving the other 28 days' notice of termination. After that time the Owner shall remove the vessel from the Trust's property
