The award can be applied for at successive stages throughout the duration of the course. The award could be used to cover course fees (other than University course fees), equipment or utensils required to undertake the course, IT equipment and help with travelling and living costs to assist the individual with achieving their qualifications.

The application form should be submitted by 1 September each year.
